2. Contractor, sub-contractor or the entity performing the work shall remove all temporary parking restriction signs upon completion of the work
3. For Operating Equipment and Park Work Vehicles, if inside CBD, then START no earlier than 8:00 P.M. and END no later than 6:00 A.M.
4. A copy of the permit must remain on-site 24 hours per day for inspector's review. Posting a copy on barricades is acceptable.
5. Permittee must provide a sign which identifies the telephone number and company or person performing the work. Signage may be affixed to barricades.
6. For Operating Equipment and Park Work Vehicles, if Non-Residential Street is outside the CBD, then START no earlier than 9:00 A.M. and END no later than 4:00 P.M. or 7:00 PM to 6:00 AM.
7. Pedestrian walkway must be kept free of all obstructions and debris.
8. All work shall be in accordance with CDOT Rules and Regulations for Construction in the Public Way and City of Chicago Municipal Code. Work to be performed as per plans and specifications. All traffic control will be the responsibility of the contractor, and must comply with all CDOT and MUTCD standards.
9. No work in or use of the public right of way is to be done when a special event is taking place. It is up to the applicant to determine if an event is scheduled. To obtain a listing of programs or events within the City of Chicago please dial 311 when you are within the City boundaries.
10. For Operating Equipment and Park Work Vehicles, if the Residential Street is Outside the CBD, then START no earlier than 7:00 A.M. and END no later than 3:00 P.M.
11. Maintain fire hydrant and manhole access.
