Restrictions:

1. Contractor, sub-contractor or the entity performing the work shall remove all temporary parking restriction signs upon completion of the work
2. To have no-parking signs REPOSTED if torn down call 312-747-5085 and provide your service request number (SR#)
3. Portable toilets are not considered materials or equipment with regards to this permit and are not allowed on the public way.
4. Per the Chicago Municipal Code (8-32-140), commonly referred to as the noise ordinance. No person shall use or cause the use of any mechanical equipment or tool operated by fuel or electric power in building, construction, repair or demolition operations between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. within 600 feet of any residential building or hospital. The applicable hours associated with this restriction are 8:00pm to 8:00am.
5. The work hour restrictions listed within this section are to be followed regardless of the hours listed on any posted no parking signage. General Occupy permits:
6. These restrictions shall supersede any conflicting information listed anywhere else on this permit.
7. Every person who engages in non-emergency excavation or demolition shall provide notice through 811 Chicago to the persons who own and operate the underground facilities in and near the excavation or demolition area, not less than 48 hours (exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays), but no more than 14 calendar days, in advance of the start of the excavation or demolition. Please review Municipal Code of Chicago § 10-21 and the Excavator Handbook (posted on [811 Chicago's website](#)) for additional information related to Chicago's one-call regulations, including outlining the dig site, extending dig tickets, and remarking work sites.
8. A copy of the permit must remain on-site 24 hours per day for inspector's review. Posting a copy on barricades is acceptable.
9. Permittee must provide a sign which identifies the telephone number and company or person performing the work. Signage may be affixed to barricades.
10. All work shall be in accordance with CDOT Rules and Regulations for Construction in the Public Way and City of Chicago Municipal Code. Work to be performed as per plans and specifications. All traffic control will be the responsibility of the contractor, and must comply with all CDOT and MUTCD standards.
11. At least 3 of 4 corners at any intersection must be accessible at all times
12. Contractor must secure plating over all openings in the roadway and secure all sidewalk/parkway openings when unattended, until such time when the road surface is restored.
13. No work in or use of the public right of way is to be done when a special event is taking place. It is up to the applicant to determine if an event is scheduled. To obtain a listing of programs or events within the City of Chicago, please dial 311 when you are within the City boundaries.
14. If the activity authorized by this permit is associated with an approved OUC project (as noted above), then all applicants—including the permittee and subcontractors—agree to abide by the comments and conditions posted by each OUC member in the "transmittal review form."
15. Start Time no Earlier than 8:00pm End Time no Later than 6:00am Sunday through Thursday
16. Start Time no Earlier than 8:00am End Time no Later than 8:00pm Saturday and Sunday

MAINTAIN AT LEAST 2 FEET OF CLEARANCE FROM THE IRRIGATION SERVICE LINE. THE CONTRACTOR'S WORK MUST CONFORM TO CDOT CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS.
